
CHÂTEAU DU PETIT LAC

AOP BERGERAC SUD-OUEST





Chateau Petit Lac is made from a blend of Merlot, Cabernet Sauvignon and Cabernet Franc.

Domain history:

The family Farjout has been working on the vineyards for few generations. Denis Farjout is taking care of the vineyard and the winery. Located in Fonroque, in the middle of Bergerac area, Chateau Petit Lac has received many awards over the last few years.

Terroir:

The reds wines from the Bergerac appellation are traditionally more complex than any others. It is due to presence of the river Dordogne and exceptional limestone soils. The wines of this region are also benefiting of a maritime climate which brings winds from the Atlantic Ocean.

Vinification:

Fully ripen grapes are harvested and sorted out. Then the winemaking at the Château du Petit Lac is traditional and the temperature is regulated in stainless steel tanks.

<u>Tasting notes</u>:

This wine has a clean and honest attack. Fruits are omnipresent, giving a fine and generous wine.

Food Pairing:

With cold cuts, grilled red meats or both hard cheeses (French emmental, comté) and soft cheeses (young cantal, bethmale, gouda, etc.)









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
