Located in the southern Burgundy, the Beaujolais region only works its red wines with 100% Gamay.

Domain history:

This estate, brought together in 2013, used to be divided into several plots between the villages of Vaux and Blacé in southern Beaujolais. The Blacé plot has had several owners and has a rich soil, which gives the wine more character. The Vaux plot had been owned for three generations by the Aurabaux family.

Terroir:

Boasting a unique soil at 450m above sea level, our highland vineyards are ideally exposed to the sun (south-southeast) facing the Saone plain. The surrounding landscape is remarkable for its wide and open view over the hills of Beaujolais.

Vinification:

We practice sustainable farming on these old vines, aged between 30 to 70 years. The harvest is conducted manually, with whole grapes, and the winemaking is performed traditionally at controlled temperature. The grapes undergo hot pressing and are aged in a stainless steel tank. Earth filtration is employed.

Tasting notes :

Our wine has a beautiful ruby color, and a rich nose filled with red fruits and spices. The palate is round, with silky tannins. The wine has a long lasting taste.

Food Pairing :

Perfect as an aperitif with tapas, cold cuts, mixed salads, red meats, or cheese.
